Daly City-Colma Honorary Rotarian Dr. Joseph Peter Simini was given a silver plaque by Piemontesi Nel Mondo of Northern California "in grateful appreciation for substantial contribution" at a dinner at the Fratellanza Club in Oakland, CA on Saturday, May 6, 2006. He was introduced by Past President Andrew Canepa.

Dr. Simini reviewed the history of the association, the strides it has made in bringing Piedmontese culture and language to Northern California residents. Also, he expressed his love for his heritage which came to America with his parents, Paul Simini and Ida Moro Simini. Dr. Simini graduated from S. Bonaventure College in 1940 at the age of 15 with a BS in Math/minors in physics and Philosophy. He returned in 1948 and graduated from St. Bonaventure University in 1949 with a MBA in Accounting/Business Administration degree.

He went to San Francisco in 1950, achieved a CPA certificate, and taught from 1954 to 1979 at the University of San Francisco. He published six books in his field. Some his six books are published in British English, Spanish, Italian and Greek.
